

### Item 1. Thai Railway Guide

The current edition of the Thai Railway Guide is effective 26 March 2016.

### Item 2. Mae Khlong Line

Service on the Mae Khlong Line is scheduled to resume 1 April 2016 after extensive track rehabilitation.

Trains will depart Mae Khlong at 0620 - 0900 - 1130 and 1500 daily.

Trains will depart Ban Laem at 0830 - 1110 - 1430 and 1740 daily.

Travel time between end points is one hour. Trains speed is increased to 60 kilometres per hour.

Service is free for Thai citizens. Fares for others range from 3 Baht to 10 Baht depending on distance travelled.

### Item 3. Trains 251 and 252

These trains now originate and terminate at Thon Buri instead of Bang Sue Junction and are now ordinary passenger trains instead of mixed trains.

### Item 4. Trains 35 and 36

Due to shortage of electric locomotives in Malaysia, Trains 35 and 36 are temporarily suspended between Hat Yai Junction, Thailand, and Butterworth, Malaysia. The following schedule is offered as a substitute:

All trains operate daily.

SRT 947 and 950 are air conditioned Diesel Rail Cars, fare is 80 Baht.

KTMB 2950 and 2951 are new air conditioned electric commuter trains. Fare is 11.40 Malaysian Ringgits.

Times shown in Malaysia are one hour ahead of Thailand time.
